- **Dec 18 |** Christmas caroling at the nursing home

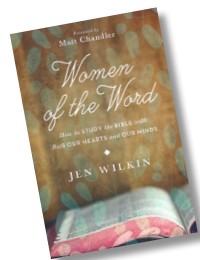
